# New Choir / Revitalization Grant

## Summary

SJMP will award a grant to a church starting or revitalizing a choir program on July 1, 2025. The purpose of this grant is to support fledgling choir programs or established music ministries fostering a new program element by offering resources and professional support.

Elements awarded in the grant include:

- Complementary 1-Year Membership to SJMP
- \$1000 to support ministry needs
- Quarterly program consultations with SJMP colleagues to help recipients maximize their SJMY Membership, discuss program challenges, and celebrate/build upon program successes.

## Application Requirements & Restrictions

- Applying institutions must be located in the United States
- Be an established Non-Profit organization
- Starting a new choir OR revitalizing an existing ministry
- Previous grant recipients may not apply again in the following calendar year
- Recipients must submit an [impact report](#) by July 1, 2026.


